Race Information

REGISTRATION:

- **To register by mail**, fill out the entry form on the back of this brochure, sign it and mail with payment to the address on the form.
- **Online registration** is available at active.com.
- **Day-of-race is available.** Payment via cash or check only.

RACE INFORMATION:

- Each race in the summer series will feature a 5K Run and a 5K Walk
- Free entry is available to all kids, 17 and under as long as you pre-register by mailing the entry to the ARR post office box (t-shirt not included). Free entry will be not be granted if you (1) call the club hotline the day before the race to try to register, (2) wait till the day of race to register or (3) fax your entry to the ARR. If you register on-line, you will not receive a refund from the ARR.
- Overall (run and walk) and age group awards (run only) will be given out at each race. Only one medal per person (i.e., no double dipping)
- There is a point series with medals to the top 3 overall run and top 3 overall walk as well as the following age groups (run only): 10 and under, 11-13, 14-17, 18-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75 and over. Entrants must complete 4 races to qualify for series ending awards that are distributed at the I-Did-A-Run on September 14.
- T-shirts will be available for purchase throughout the series.
- Registration opens at 5:30 AM and closes at 6:15 AM
- Food and drink will be provided after the race.
- Rest of the summer series schedule #4 at Kiwanis Park on July 19 and #5 is at South Mountain Park on August 10.
- Summer Series #4 is a part of the 2008 ARR Grand Prix Series, too.
